Dear Property Owner:

The Summit County Engineer intends to prepare a drainage study for the Springfield Lake Watershed as shown on the attached map. Our engineers and consultant, CT Consultants, Inc, will prepare the study based on surveying, mapping, and other field observations.

Accordingly, we wish to advise you that it will be necessary for the consultant and survey crews to enter upon a portion of your property to obtain field measurements and collect data needed in connection with this project. If you, the owner, do not live or conduct business at this site, please inform the tenants of our planned work.

In addition, it is necessary for the consultants to visually examine, photograph, take measurements or make other field observations within the project area. The field observations will be primarily along the watershed's streams shown on the attached map. However, it may be necessary for the consultants and surveyors to enter upon a portion of your property to obtain information needed in connection with this project.

Sections 5517.01 and 163.03 of the Ohio Revised Code authorize such entries, but also require reimbursement be made for any actual damage resulting from such work. The consultant has been given strict instructions concerning the preservation of private property. Every effort will be made to minimize the disturbance to all properties. In addition to the mailing of this letter of notification, the consultants and surveyors will carry a copy of this letter. Sometimes it may be necessary to set field stakes or other markers within the limits of your property for future reference. We request that these stakes not be disturbed. If at any time you feel that any of the consultants and surveyors have not given the proper attention to your property, or if there are any hazards associated with your property or the immediate area that could cause harm, please contact Mark Delisio, P.E., (330)-540-1987, [mdelisio@ctconsultants.com](mailto:mdelisio@ctconsultants.com).

The consultants and surveyors will not be able to provide any specific information or answers to your questions concerning this project. They will simply be collecting information necessary for the preparation of the study.

The survey work near your property is scheduled to start November 6, 2023 and will last through the Spring of 2024. However, it may be necessary from time to time to obtain additional data to improve the mapping.
